It looks at light, sound and touch.

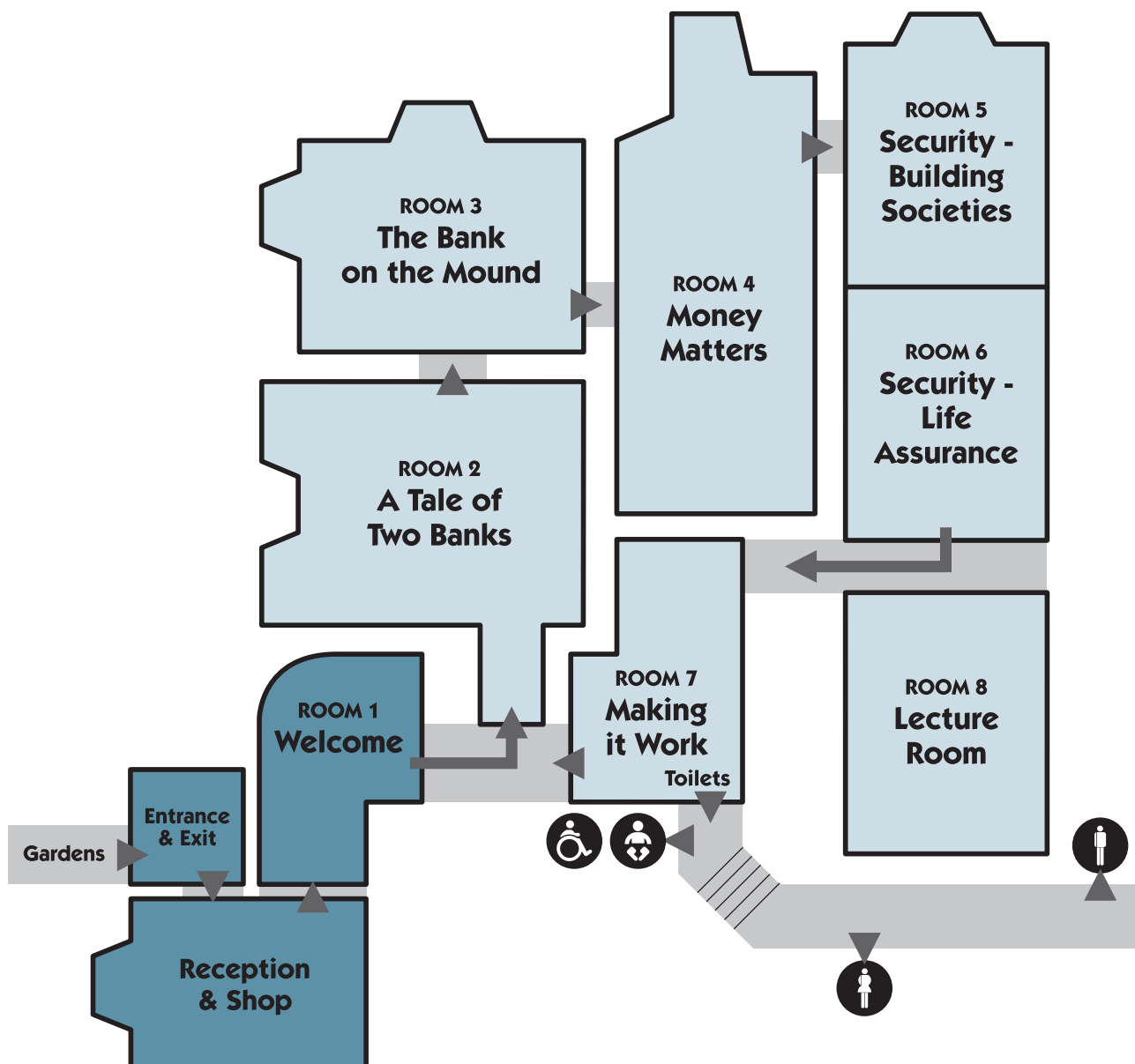

- Well lit

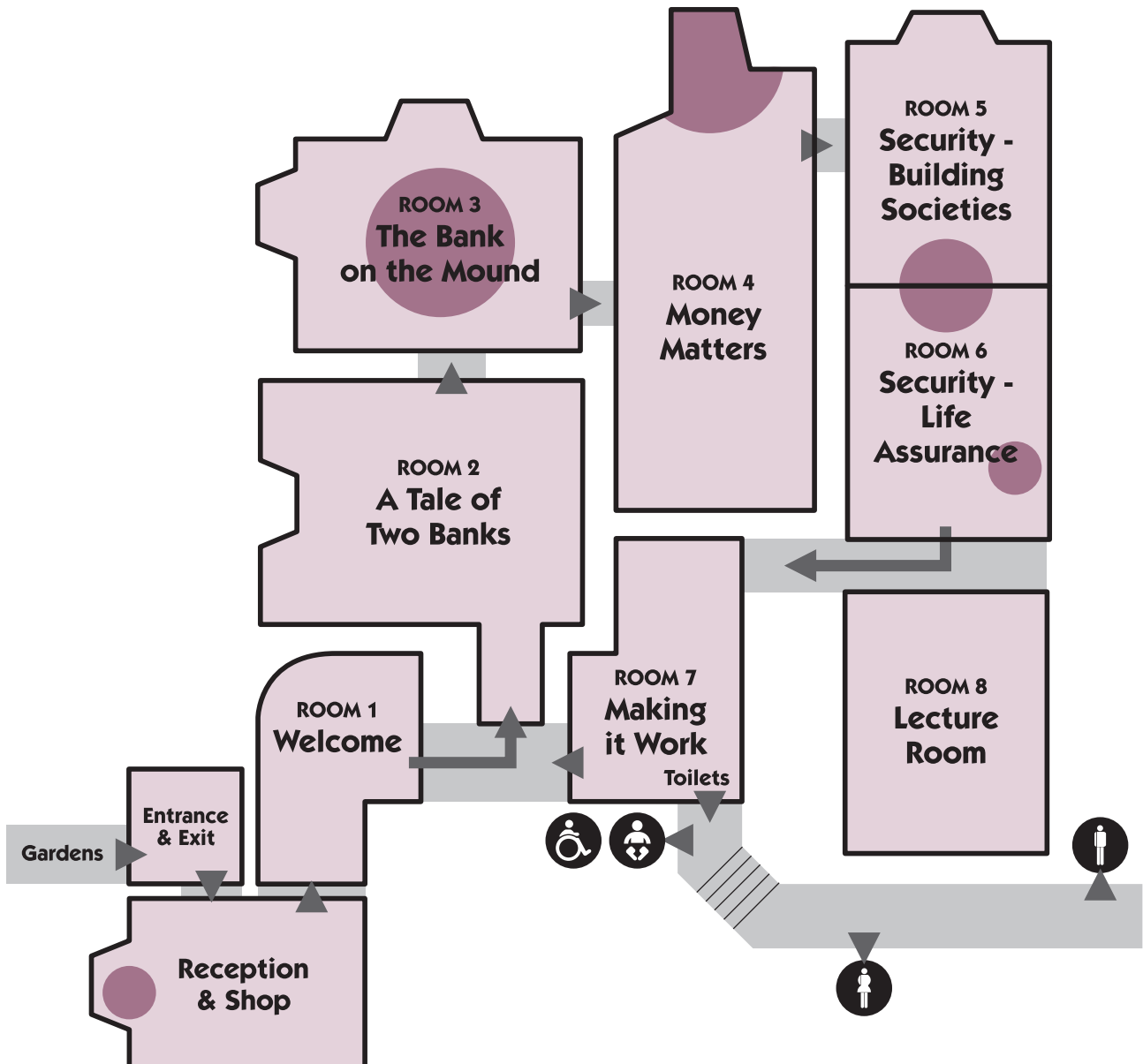


Sound
