








## Visiting Museum on the Mound







• I'm going on a visit to Museum on the Mound in Edinburgh.




This is Nicola, the Visitor Services Officer. I might see her on my way in and out of the museum.

- They are here to help me. I can ask them questions.






- When I arrive, one of the museum team will show me where to go.

- They will tell me what I'll be doing while I visit the museum.










- I will take part in at least 3 activities at the museum.

- If there is anything that makes me uncomfortable, I can let the museum team know.




## MUS£UM MOUND

Today I \_\_\_\_\_\_ struck my own coin.




It is a replica of a 13<sup>th</sup> century Scottish silver penny from the reign of Alexander III.
